

County SteerValidation

August 31st, 2020 at the Fairgrounds

County steer validation will take place August 31st at the fairgrounds at 6pm. If you plan to have a steer validated, you must let the Extension Office know by August 14th, 2020. County tags are free of charge. These steers will be eligible for the 2021 Refugio County Jr. Livestock Show only. You do not need to validate again if you major show validated your steers in June. Major Show Sheep & Goat Tag Order

Due August 28, 2020 to the Extension Office

Any 4-H Member wanting to show Sheep or Goats at a 2021 Major Livestock Show will need to place their tag order by September 1st, 2020. Order forms will be sent via email to all 4-H Families on August 1st. Tags will be \$17.00 a piece. Payment is due at the time of ordering. Validation will take place in the month of October, more details to follow at a later date. Major Show validated animals do not have to be re-validated for county.

Any one wanting to show a heifer at a 2021 Major Livestock Show in the Spring or at the 2021 Refugio County Jr. Livestock Show needs to place a UIN order. Each individual UIN is \$17.00. An email will be sent out by Jonelle August 1st with the order form. Invoices will be sent after validation. Validation will take place toward the end of October. More details will follow at a later date.
