<u>4-H Online Enrollment</u>

Please remember to get registered for 4-H ASAP! The new enrollment platform is called 4-H Online. The website is <u>v2.4honline.com</u>. Please only use Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox as your web browser when trying to sign up. Other web browsers are not compatible and can cause issues with the enrollment process.

Remember: if you plan on showing an animal at the 2021 Refugio County Fair, you must be registered by October 31st, 2020.

The enrollment fee is \$25. After October 31st, there will be a state wide increase to \$30.

Clover Kid's Corner!

Join us <u>October 8th at 6pm</u> online via Microsoft Teams for an informational meeting over the Clover Kids Food and Nutrition Program. This year, all Clover Kids (5 and in Kindergarten through 2nd grade) will have the opportunity to participate in a modified Food Show and Food Challenge Competition.

<u>Food Show</u> is an individual event where a dish is prepared ahead of time, brought to the competition, and presented to a panel of judges. The 4-Her will tell the judges what their dish is, how they made it, and some health facts about their dish.

<u>Food Challenge</u> is a team event. The teams will be made of 3 or 4 members and each team will be given one category and one main item. They will have a "grocery store" available to buy more ingredients and will have 40 minutes to create a dish and present it to the judges.

The informational will explain the rules in detail and help answer any questions! Tune in on October 8th!

<u>Additional Clover Kid 4-H Projects</u>

PeeWee Livestock Projects

- Rabbits
 - Goats
- Mini Herefords
 - Swine

For all Clover Kid livestock projects, they will purchase and raise their own animal. The only exception is swine. The Clover Kid will have a mentor (older 4-H member) and they will show their mentors pig at the fair. Rabbits will be validated on February 11th. Goats must be purchased, on feed by January 1st, and verified by the Extension Agent. Cattle must be on feed and verified by the Extension Agent by November 1st.

<u>Calf Scramble Participants</u>

If you are interested in participating in the calf scramble in Fort Worth, San Antonio, and/or Houston at the livestock show, during a Rodeo performance, please let the Extension Office know as soon as possible.

<u>Age Ranges for Scramble Opportunities:</u>

Fort Worth- 14-17 years old

- If you catch a calf, you will win a certificate to purchase and show a beef heifer or dairy heifer.
- San Antonio- 12-17 years old
- If you catch a calf, you will win a certificate to purchase and show any specie of registered breeding livestock
 Houston- 14-18 years old
 - If you catch a calf, you will win a certificate to purchase and show a beef heifer or market steer.

<u>Major Show Sign Up Day</u>

Thursday, November 5th at the Extension Office 8am-6:30pm

Anyone interested in showing State Validated Livestock in Fort Worth, San Angelo, San Antonio, Rio Grande Valley, Houston, and/or Austin at a Major Livestock Show will need to come by the Extension Office on November 5th and sign up for the shows. Payment is due at the time of sign up.

<u>Refugio County Livestock Show Validation</u>

November 21st, 2020 at the Precinct 3 yard at the Fairgrounds 8am-10am

Any one who ordered Major Show Swine Tags or anyone wanting to show a pig, sheep, or goat in the 2021 Refugio County Fair will need to come to the Precinct 3 yard on November 21st to have their animal validated. Major Show Swine will have a different line than county validations. We will direct you as you arrive.

You must be in line before 10am to have your animal validated.
